ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE ESL STUDY PROGRAM

The English language program at the Dominican International Institute has been designed for local or foreign students who are interested in learning or improving their language proficiency, to pursue higher education in the United States, to teach English or to obtain their professional license.

Admission to this program is open to anyone, without any requirement of TOEFEL or other English Language Testing. All students are initially admitted to the First Trimester and are tested periodically for advance classes as they progress.

All programs, including Continuing Education programs are available on-line. Credits earned can be transferred for training in many other professions e.g. Business, Health Care, Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences or Language & Cultures. New classes start in January, April, July and October. Accelerated programs, credits for previous studies, scholarships, student loans and easy monthly payment facilities are available.
